Lorenzo Migliorati is Associate Professor at the University of Verona, department of Human Sciences, for the SSD SPS/08, Sociology of Culture and Communication since 01/12/2018 - DR 9878-28/11/2018. From October 1 2007 until November 30 2018 he has been Assistant Professor at the University of Verona for the SSD SPS/08, Sociology of Culture and Communication - DR 2550-08/28/2007. He has been confirmed in this role since 10/01/2010 - DR 188-01/28/2011. Since 31 January 2014, he is qualified for the role of Associated Professor for the SSD 14 C/2 Sociology of Culture and Communication (ASN 2012, L. 240 /2012, DD 222/2012).

He has been a visiting scholar at ISP - Institut des Sciences Sociales du Politique (dir. Prof. Marie Claire Lavabre) at University of Paris X Nanterre – La Défense (2012) and at the Séminaire d'Anthropologie Sociale (dir. prof. Christian Giordano) at University of Fribourg – CH (2010). He has been also research fellow at the Faculty of Philosophy at the University of Verona (2005-2007). He received a PhD in Education Sciences from the University of Verona with a doctoral thesis in sociology: "Social representations of Risk: the experience of Risk between Antiquity and Modernity"

He teaches in many bachelor's degrees and masters degrees of the University of Verona. Between others, he teaches "Sociology of Catastrophes and Cultural Traumas" for the Master's Degree in Emergency Governance at the Department of Law.

Lorenzo Migliorati is also deputy manager of the editorial collection *Strutture e culture sociali* of Franco Angeli, Milano; he is coordinator of Editorial Board of the same collections. He is member of the editorial board of following scientific reviews: "Sociologia Italiana - AIS Journal of Sociology", "Italian Sociological Review" and "Salute & Società". He has been referee for "Etnografia e Ricerca qualitativa" (Il Mulino, Bologna) and *Sociologie et Sociétés* (PUM, Montreal).

The research's interests of Lorenzo Migliorati concern following topics:

- Sociology of collective memory. In particular he studies the Theory of Collective Memory, the social processes of production and construction of memory and the social practices of memory.
- Social Traumas. In particular, he studies, with his theoretical and empirical research, the cultural processes of the construction of cultural trauma in contemporary history of Italy. He has also translated in Italian some works of Jeffrey C. Alexander, the most specialist of cultural trauma (see publications).
- Theory and history of sociology; specifically the classical French sociology and the thinking of Maurice Halbwachs, pioneer of sociological studies about collective memory. He has translated some his unpublished works in Italian (see publications).

He has taken part in national and international research projects.

Actually, he is Scientific Coordinator for the University of Verona (project partner) in the project of transnational cooperation (Interreg Alpine Space), "TrAILS – Transformation Alpine Industrial Landscapes". The lead partner is Technische Universität Munich, Landschaftsarchitektur (dir. Prof. Udo Weilacher).

In the project "PRIN 2008", financed by the Italian Ministry of Education, Universities and Research, he was deputy manager (manager: prof. Domenico Secondulfo) for the research of local unit of University of Verona as a title "La trasformazione del consumatore e la creatività imprenditoriale, il ruolo della memoria nei processi di ricostruzione e valorizzazione del prodotto locale".

For the University of Verona, he was scientific coordinator of the research's project "La resa dei conti nella storia e nella memoria" with the participation of the Istituto per la Storia della Resistenza e l'età contemporanea di Bergamo (prof.
