**Scientific activity:**

My current research focuses on enquiry on coordination skills in developmental age, in particular early school age. The research focuses on the existing correlation between motor skills and physical activity and the education and environmental settings on which said skills depend. The studies are based on motor coordination tests (KTK; Körperkoordinations Test für Kinder) and Tests for upper limbs and the relevant evaluation of the comparison between gross and fine motor skills, in order to identify the performance of the Motor Quotient (MQ) related to increasing age and body mass index in youth.
