


A trend towards a decreasing and ageing population

Divided into two periods:






The share of younger population (<29 years) in L'Argentière-la-Bessée and in the whole CC du Pays des Ecrins has decreased



The size of the personal support network correlates with some indicators of social cohesion:


the more people feel they share values and norms, the bigger is the size of both the total and local social network










IN-DEPTH INTERVIEWS

"Pechiney...It's paternalism!"

"It was the biggest industry there was. I think there were 850 people there. We couldn't talk about L'Argentière without talking about Pechiney... The people of Pechiney were privileged. You've got to admit it."

"They were provided with a wide range of services: kindergarten, sports, trips, and only those who worked in the factory benefited...the others didn't. A rift was created in the population as result..."












IN-DEPTH INTERVIEWS "When they demolished the northern part of the factory, it was something **shocking for everyone...** It marked the rebirth of L'Argentière, but also marked the end of a prosperity period"




"It was a **trauma...** It was definitely a trauma at first"




Knowledge about the ex Pechiney/AFP site (%)




Citizens' participation to the site transformation process (%)




The perception of the site as important both for the local community and young' future increases the probability to opt for an intermediate scenario.

The probability to chose a **radical scenario** increases for respondents recognizing citizens as the leading actor in the transformation process.


It seems that this choice reflects the degree of risk aversion of survey respondents.




Almost all respondents believe it will have a positive effect on local economy







Employment rate by gender and age, 2016




Employment rate by sector, 2016










The share of middle class (yearly income 12,000-36,000 euros)




Share of household making ends meet with difficulty (survey 2019)




Share of persons receiving a pension, since 2010





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



Trend in the new business creation since 2009




Business by sector (2017)



Overall most of respondents do not report any negative economic effect at personal level from the past transformation of the site ex Péchiney/AFP


Negative economic impact at personal level of past transformation of the site ex Péchiney/AFP and persistence over time (survey 2019)








Expected benefits of the site transformation and their distribution




